Casting needs:

- 5-8 adult men (20 - 60)
- 4-5 adult women (20 - 60)

Casting for the show is extremely flexible.

At least 3 actors (2 m, 1 f) will likely play multiple roles.

Linus Harcourt - a mousey bookkeeper

Mrs. Pomeroy - a widow

Greenskeeper - at the golf course, young

Harry Monday - a cliché of a private eye, a hard-boiled man with chiseled features

Billie Jean Hodecker - an ambitious, naïve woman, mid-20's

Sgt. Brogan - a policeman with no sense of humor

Stella Fontaine - a seductive by determined woman, late 20's

Cecil Deborus - a pompous man in his 40's; wears arrogance like a medal

Glamis Ludlow - a rather spooky woman, into astrology, mid-40's

David Soames - a Wall Street-type ad man, late 30's

Freida Mae Bristow - a dithering woman, works crossword puzzles, late 40's

George - a general factotum at Shady Meadows, 30's

Anita Fae Martoon - Freida's twin sister, they're never seen together

Messenger - from Western Union
